

British Skydiving First Category Event Selection Policy

Discipline	1 - Primary Method of Selection for World Cup and World Championship The following is in addition to the selection process detailed in form 230b, British Skydiving Team Selection.	2 - Secondary Method of Selection for World Cup and World Championship Only to be used if not enough competitors at National Championships to fill all slots available, or if National Championships are not completed. Any stipulations specified under the primary method of selection will also apply to use of the secondary method. NB: EPC may differentiate between World Cups and World Championships in terms of number of slots filled and funding of delegates (Eg on a Cup selection year EPC may look to fill slots from other categories at the qualifying National Championships before recourse to the previous year's Nationals).	3 - Extenuating circumstances Only to be used when it has not been possible to make selection via primary and secondary methods
Accuracy & Classic Style	National Championships results: Top 5 male, top 5 female and top 2 junior competitors according to the stated event(s) at the FCE (British Skydiving's National Championships run as a single event and there are no separate Female or Junior categories).	- Selection continues down the eligible competitors who attended the National Championships until places are filled. - Safety considerations should be taken into account; these would be the arena size and the ability to consistently land in such areas or be able to make the right decision to land out if needed. This should be referred to the TEA, or CI of the competitor's club. - If no suitable competitors from the qualifying National Championships, EPC will consider results of the most recent National Championship(s) or Grand Prix classification from the selection year whichever is most appropriate. Artistics FreeFly	National Championships results: No minimum score required.	EPC will consider results of the most recent National Championship(s), going back a maximum of 2 years.	As above

Canopy Formations	National Championships results: No minimum score required.	- Grand Prix classification from the selection year. - If GP results do not allow further selection, or there are still slots available, EPC will consider results of the most recent National Championship(s) going back a maximum of 2 years. Canopy Piloting	National Championships results: Minimum score of 300 required.	- EPC will consider results of the most recent National Championship(s) going back a maximum of 2 years. - EPC has final say in relation to other safety concerns, such as currency, in consultation with the CP TEA if possible. FS 4Way	National Championships results: - Placing in AAA followed by AA. - If placed outside of top 4 teams in the category, a minimum average 10 points should apply.	If there are still open slots teams & individuals who have proven capability (ie having posted scores at any of the Nationals or UKSLs in the last 2 years) can apply. For example, teams who came 3rd and 4th might combine 2 members from each team, or a team from Nationals the previous year or UKSL in the selection year might apply to attend. Decision made by EPC based on capability and their submitted training plan.	As above
FS 8Way	National Championships results: - Placing in senior followed by intermediate. - EPC has final say regarding teams placing well with a low score.	As per 4Way	As above
Speed	National Championships results: - working down the open results table with 3 slots reserved for female competitors, as per FAI/ISC rules. - Minimum average scores of 390 kph for Open Males and Masters age-group males; 370 kph for Open Females and Masters age-group females; 370 kph for junior males; 350 kph for junior females*	If there are still slots available, individuals who have proven capability (i.e. having posted scores at any of the Nationals or ISSA competitions in the last 2 years) can apply. The decision will be made by EPC based on capability and their submitted training plan. Minimum scores as per primary will still apply.	As above

Wingsuiting Acro	National Championships results: - Placing in senior followed by intermediate. - Minimum of 5 Dock average required - EPC has final say regarding competitors placing well with a minimal score.	As above	As above

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*As per ISC rules, Section 5, a junior competitor is a person under the age of 24 or whose 24th birthday occurs during the calendar year in which the relevant competition takes place. A master competitor is a person over the age of 50 or whose 50th birthday occurs during the calendar year in which the relevant competition takes place.
