PART 2 - MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT AND RISK ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

This declaration applies to individuals undertaking **skydiving training** at a British Skydiving affiliated Parachute Training Organisation.

By commencing training you confirm that you have read and agree to the following.

1. Acknowledgement of Risk

Skydiving training is an inherently dangerous activity.

Even when conducted with appropriate instruction, supervision and equipment, participation carries a **risk of serious injury or death**.

By undertaking skydiving training you voluntarily accept these risks.

2. Compliance with Instructions

Student skydivers must:

- follow all instructions given by instructors and authorised personnel
- comply with all operational and safety procedures
- participate only in training authorised by a **British Skydiving affiliated Parachute Training Organisation**.

3. Medical Fitness

Students must ensure they are **medically fit to undertake skydiving training**.

Students must complete the required **medical self-declaration or medical certification** before commencing training.

If a student's health changes in a way that may affect their ability to skydive safely, they must seek appropriate medical advice and inform their instructor before continuing.

Medical requirements and forms are available online.

4. Insurance

I acknowledge and accept that I am not covered by any British Skydiving Third-Party Liability Insurance Policy.

5. Safety Responsibilities

Students must comply with all **safety requirements and operational procedures** issued by British Skydiving and the training organisation.

Failure to comply with safety requirements may result in training being suspended or terminated.

6. Data Protection

British Skydiving processes personal data in accordance with the **UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR)** and the **Data Protection Act 2018**.

Details are available in the Privacy Notice online.

7. Age Requirement

The minimum age for skydiving is **16 years**.

Participants under the age of 18 must have **parent or legal guardian consent** before commencing training.

8. Governing Law

This agreement is governed by the **laws of England and Wales**.

9. Full Membership

Applying to become a FULL British Skydiving member can be done at any time at the Parachute Training Organisation (PTO), by returning a Full Membership Application to British Skydiving HQ.

10. JSAT

British Skydiving JSAT membership is only valid at The Joint Services Parachute Training Organisations.
